## We are learning...

## Reading El and Writing: - Reading and writing narratives: Poems and Porquoi tales about Frogs

The first half of the unit focuses on reading and analyzing poetry and pourquoi tales. We will listen to a variety of pourquoi tales, and then plan our own pourquoi tale about frogs. Students will choose to publish them in a variety of ways..

Then... students closely read poems about frogs with a focus on vocabulary, structure of poetry, and figurative language. Students will create their own poetry book about frogs.

Math: - Our unit on multiplication and division focuses on using factors 6-9. Students are

expected to use strategies they have learned earlier in the year. Using Doubles strategy, break apart a factor (distributive) will be practiced and reviewed through out this unit. We will solve variety of word problems to practice these strategies. Please encourage your child to continue learning multiplication facts.

## Social Studies-

We continue to learn about our Government, roles and responsibilities of leaders in state and local government. Then we will learn how movement of goods, people, and ideas is impacted by the geography of a place or region.
